

IS IT FREE?

Yes. The AMEP is funded by the Australian Government and is free for students.

You can also access **free childcare** (for children under school age) while you are in class.

WHO CAN JOIN?

You may be able to join the AMEP if...



YOU ARRIVED ON AN ELIGIBLE VISA

including Family, Skilled, Partner or Humanitarian visas. Some temporary visas may also apply.



YOU NEED TO IMPROVE YOUR ENGLISH

and have not been assessed as having Vocational English or higher.



YOU ARE OVER 18 YEARS OLD

or aged 15-17 in some cases.

If you apply and are eligible, we will invite you to a meeting at your local TAFE.

This helps us find the right class for your English level and goals.
