Skills for Education & Employment Program (SEE)

Tailored training to upskill union members.

The SEE Program provides access to foundation skills training for all [eligible Australians](#) seeking to improve their reading, writing, maths and basic computer skills, enabling them to actively participate in the economy and society.

The SEE Program offers free, customised training to help union members improve their skills, leading to increased confidence and job satisfaction.

Union members can benefit from a tailored training plan that improves verbal and written communication skills and enhances numeracy and digital skills. This can lead to increased knowledge and confidence which may lead to reduced staff turnover.

TAFE Queensland will work with you to identify your members' skills needs, typically through one on one skills assessments, and to develop relevant, flexible and tailored training, to address their needs.

As a Union, you are encouraged to support the delivery of the project. You can do this by organising time for your members to complete training during work hours and by offering an appropriate training space for the training to be delivered.
