TAFE qualifications explained

We offer a full range of nationally-recognised qualifications from entry-level certificates through to bachelor degrees. We also offer comprehensive trade training from beginner to advanced levels.

CERTIFICATES

Certificate I Certificate I courses cover base-level skills for entry into the workforce.

Certificate II Certificate II courses prepare you for entry-level positions or apprenticeships in a variety of industries.

Certificate III Certificate III qualification are ideal for those wanting to gain a trade, change careers or move out of

entry-level roles.

Certificate IV Certificate IV courses typically interest those who want to advance their careers in the industry they

already work in, or further develop skills and knowledge acquired through previous study.

DIPLOMAS

Diplomas Diploma courses develop broad and in-depth skills in professional, technical or creative fields.

Advanced Diplomas Advanced diploma is ideal for ambitious professionals wanting to fast-track their career.

DEGREES

Associate Degrees Associate degree students will develop a broad range of high-level practical and professional skills.

Bachelor degree students will gain the skills and knowledge needed for many professional, high-level **Bachelor Degrees**

or management jobs.

TRADE QUALIFICATIONS

Pre-apprenticeship courses

Pre-apprenticeships are a great way to improve your prospects of gaining an apprenticeship, develop

practical skills in your trade, and gain credit towards a full apprenticeship.

Earn while you learn by undertaking an apprenticeship with TAFE Queensland. Completing an **Apprenticeships**

apprenticeship is essential if you want to become a qualified tradesperson.

School-based apprenticeships Allows you to earn and learn in your chosen industry and begin training towards a recognised

vocational education and training (VET) qualification while you complete high school.

Traineeships Much like apprenticeships, traineeships give you the opportunity to combine training with a paying job.

Trainees are trained in vocational areas such as individual support, early childhood education and care,

or business.

Post-trade training Post-trade training is great if you want to specialise, gain a specific trade licence, gain credit towards

university, or expand your horizons after completing an apprenticeship.

DOUBLE AND DUAL QUALIFICATIONS

Dual qualifications You can enrol in two qualifications of different levels (such as a certificate and a diploma, or a diploma

and a degree) and gain two qualifications at the same time.

Double qualifications Double qualifications are two courses of the same level (such as two certificates, or two diplomas) that

give you a broader range of skills than if you choose to study a single qualification on its own.

University pathways

TAFE Queensland has a range of pathway options that can get you started on your university degree sooner. If you didn't finish Year 12, complete the required prerequisites, or get the ATAR you needed, TAFE Queensland can help you get into your preferred university degree.

ADULT TERTIARY PREPARATION (ATP)

Our Adult Tertiary Preparation (ATP) course is for anyone wanting to gain or improve their ranking in order to study at university. ATP is recognised as a Year 12 alternative and is ideal for adults who've been away from formal study for some time. Successful completion of the course will allow you to apply to QTAC for a tertiary ranking and will give you the university entrance prerequisites in English, Maths and Science.

UNIVERSITY PREREQUISITES

If you need to complete prerequisite courses to get you into your preferred university degree then our Unilearn courses can help. We offer a range of preparatory courses such as Senior Science and Maths A, B and C. Our courses are accredited by universities across Australia and meet university entrance requirements.

IMPROVE YOUR ATAR

Completing any TAFE Queensland certificate III, certificate IV, diploma, advanced diploma, or associate degree may improve your ATAR score and allow you to get into your preferred university degree. Another added benefit of studying this way is that you can start working in your industry straight away, using your certificate or diploma skills while you finish off your degree.

CREDITS

If you study a qualification at TAFE Queensland you may be eligible to receive credit towards your degree. This can save you time and money off your university degree. For example, if you complete a diploma course at TAFE Queensland you may be able to receive as much as one year of credit towards an undergraduate degree in a similar field.

STUDY A DEGREE WITH US

TAFE Queensland has partnered with some of Australia's leading universities to deliver world-class degrees in a practical, job-focused training environment. You will graduate with a university degree as well as the hands on skills and applied learning that makes TAFE Queensland graduates so highly sought after by employers.

Our diploma-to-degree pathways mean that you can complete a diploma and bachelor degree in the time it usually takes to complete a degree alone. You'll graduate ahead of the pack with academic knowledge backed up by real-world skills.

Studying in this way will save you time and money. It can also give you a head start in the job market allowing you to put your diploma skills into practice in the industry while you complete your university studies.

Completion of a TAFE Queensland Diploma may allow you direct entry into certain nominated Degrees at TAFE Queensland's University partners or may provide credit points towards your Degree, subject to you meeting all of the requirements for admission stipulated by the relevant University

LEARNING SUPPORT

Provided by specialised teachers, get support in exam preparation, assignment writing, time management, making presentations, study skills, language, literacy and numeracy support and general study skills.



DISABILITY SUPPORT

Disability support is available, including locating and organising equipment and teacher liaison on your behalf.



ONLINE SUPPORT

Access to TAFE Queensland learning support and resources including Studiosity. Through Studiosity, you can chat online to expert tutors who can help you with your studies. Studiosity is available for students studying qualifications Certificate III and above.



INDIGENOUS STUDENT SUPPORT

An Indigenous Student Support Officer is available to assist with various issues and to support you during your studies.



LIBRARY

You will have access to a range of online and hard copy resources at our libraries.



INTERNET/WIFI

You will have access to TAFE Queensland's WiFi and student computers with internet access across all of our locations.



FACILITIES

Campuses are generally located within walking distance to food and beverage outlets. Most of our parking is provided for no or minimal charge.

Ways to study

Everyone learns differently. TAFE Queensland's flexible range of delivery modes are designed to help you get the most out of your time with us. We offer traditional on-campus study as well as hands-on apprenticeships and traineeships, online study, TAFE at School courses, and the ability to complete qualifications through recognition of prior learning.

STUDY MODES

ON-CAMPUS

Learn face-to-face with a teacher in one of our learning spaces like a classroom, workshop, laboratory or simulated learning environment. In this mode you will attend a TAFE Queensland campus 100 per cent of the time, but you can also interact with your teachers using live video or web conference programs.

ON-CAMPUS WITH SOME ONLINE

You'll primarily learn face-to-face with a teacher in one of our learning spaces like a classroom, workshop, laboratory or simulated learning environment. In this mode you will attend a TAFE Queensland campus most of the time, but some of your classes or training may be via video or web conference programs.

ONLINE SELF-PACED

Our online self-directed courses are designed for students who want the flexibility to study at their own pace and prefer not to be locked into attending classes at specified times. You may have opportunities to interact with teachers and other students through web conference programs (like Zoom).

ONLINE VIRTUAL CLASSROOM

Your course will be delivered online, but to a scheduled timetable. You will interact with your teachers and other students using live video or web conference programs. Your assessments and examination will be completed mainly online.

ONLINE WITH ON-CAMPUS TRAINING

Your course is primarily online, however you will need to come into a campus to undertake face-to-face learning and/or assessment. Any face-to-face components will be teacher-led or organised and will enable you to connect with other students in one of our learning spaces. Assessment for this mode may be through online or faceto-face assessments and examination.

WORK-BASED LEARNING

Students get their training on the job, supervised by their employer. This could be while doing work experience, vocational placement, or doing paid work at their place of employment. Work-based learning also includes completing work-based projects while under supervision.

APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINEESHIP

Get the skills while you pay the bills with an apprenticeship or traineeship through TAFE Queensland. We work with employers from a range of industries to give you the tuition and formal qualification that complements your on-the-job training.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) helps you gain credit towards a qualification based on the skills you already have.

TAFE AT SCHOOL

If you're a Year 10^* , 11 or 12 student, you can complete a range of certificate I, certificate II and certificate III courses at school. TAFE at School courses work in with your existing high school studies and may also count towards your Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE).

WORKLOAD

FULL TIME

This option is perfect if you're ready to jump in and give your studies everything you've got! Studying full time at TAFE Queensland is the quickest and most immersive way to get the qualifications you need. You'll be jobready in no time!

PART TIME

Is your life already in the fast lane? If you're busy working or juggling family, this may be the perfect way to gain the skills you need, while maintaining that all-important life balance.

SHORT COURSES

Experiment with a new hobby, up-skill for work or test the waters for a career change. No matter what you're looking for, we've got you covered.

VOCATIONAL PLACEMENT

If required as a requisite of your course, you may need to attend a vocational placement, no matter which mode of study you choose, and a teacher might attend to observe and assess.



UNIQUE STUDENT IDENTIFIER (USI)

You will need a USI prior to enrolling in your course. To create your USI, go to usi.gov.au. If you need help, our Student Services team can assist prior to your enrolment. Your USI will help keep your training records and results together in an online account controlled by you.

If eligible you will receive subsidised training for one certificate III level qualification from a list of eligible courses.

FREE TAFE FOR UNDER 25s

Are you a Queensland resident? Have you just finished Year 12? You might be eligible for Fee-Free training. The Queensland Government will pay the full cost of a number of eligible certificate III qualifications in high-priority study areas under the Certificate 3 Guarantee and User Choice programs.

HIGHER LEVEL SKILLS SUBSIDY (HLS)


