FIVE STEPS TO SUCCESS

1. CHOOSE YOUR COURSE:
Find the best course that works for you on our website or by talking to your local Indigenous Student Support Officer (ISSO) or school guidance officer.

2. APPLY:
You can apply online from your course page on the website by completing a student details form.

3. ID & IDENTIFY:
Do you have the right ID docs? Make sure you include them with application and tick the box to identify if you are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

5. STUDY:
If you have any troubles or need guidance with your course, talk to your teacher. Access to study assistance is available to you too.

4. SUPPORT:
You can get advice or support from your local Indigenous Student Support Officer (ISSO) if you need help.

HOW TO APPLY

Depending on what you want to study you can apply a few different ways.

FILL OUT THE FORM

Fill out a form and return your current documents, either over the counter or using Send Safely, to your local TAFE Queensland or person helping you apply.

- We will support you to complete your application.
- We will stay in touch to let you know how it's progressing.

Tip: Don't forget to tick the box to identify for access to ISSO and funding support.

APPLY ONLINE

- You can apply for your course online from the course page on our website - just click Apply Now and follow the steps in our Student Portal to complete your application.
- Have your Student ID number ready and be prepared to provide your details and upload ID documents.

SUPPORT TO APPLY

- Your family, school, youth worker or person in your community can help you to complete your application.
- Your local TAFE Queensland Indigenous Student Support officer can also help you apply.

ACCESSABILITY SUPPORT

AccessAbility Support Officers may assist students with disabilities to:

- Identify how your disability may impact your study.
- Make a plan with reasonable adjustments to help you and your educator with your studies.
- Arrange in-class support, coaching, assistive technology and interpreting, where required or available.
